About the NBS 12

- Scope and references
 - The Swedish Boating Survey 2010 (and 2004) used as template
 - The Task; To describe the Norwegian pleasure craft market:
 - Canoes/kayaks
 - Dinghys, rowing boats without engine
 - Motorboats w/wo sleepover facilities
 - Sailboats mw/wo sleepover facilities
 - Secondary; try to compare Norwegian data with the Swedish surveys(2004-2010)
- Comprehensive study
 - 4652 Norwegian households participated, interviewed primarily by telephone
 - *“...the person in the household between 18 and 74 years who has the responsibility for the households pleasure craft.”*
 - From above, 1141 households who owns one or more boats were interviewed(30mins).
 - Covers the whole country, overweight in regions with more boats.
 - Statisticly weighted afterwards to represent the whole population.




50% of the boat skippers does not have any formal competence, but are positive to reasonable regulations




Every 4th household own a boat

- More than 100 000 km coastline, a spectacular base for boating
- Every 4th household own a boat
 - Aprox 505 000 households
 - Largest density on the westcoast, where every 3rd household have a boat
- Major reason for ***not*** having a boat
 - Other priorities/interests (34%)
 - Not interested, (33%)
 - Too expensive (25%)



50% of the population has been at sea in a pleasure craft in 2011!

- 51% of the population (18-74 years) has been on one ore more boat trips in 2011
- Boats most used in northern Norway and in the south-west
- Which boats were used the most:
 - Sailboats 83 %
 - Motorboats w/sleepover fac. 80 %
 - Motorboats wo/ sleepover fac. 79 %
 - Small boats w/o engine 49 %



Membership in a boating organisation or yacht club

- 3 out of 10 households are members in a yacht club or a boating organisation

The Norwegian coast is a unique source for outdoor activities

- 50% of the respondents are planning to spend their vacation by the Norwegian coast the next two years
- 1 out of 6 are thinking of buying a second hand boat the next 5 years
- Aprox 4,5 % says that they, most likely, will buy a new boat the next 5 years
- Market potential for aprox 90 000 new boats in Norway next 5 years!






How important is ... when you are out in your boat?

50/50 better/worse-answers regarding water quality

- Are there any ***changes*** in the water quality in your boating period?
 - 10%: Yes, to the better
 - 9%: Yes, more polluted
 - 74%: No difference
- Highest part of «better» answers in the highest populated areas
- **"Yes, better water quality"** shown in the map pr region



The survey also touch other environmental issues

- Just 4 % of the population think that boating have a major negative impact on the environment
- 18 % of the boats have a waste water suction adapter on deck

- 27 % of the households have a boat engine which is not in use.
 - 61 % are positive to an engine scrap deposit
- 10 % of the households own a boat which is concidered scrapped
 - 52 % of these boats are between 9 -14 feet
 - 62 % made of GRP and 30% made of wood

- 70 % of the boaters never disturbed by noise of other boaters/engines
 - 2,4 % allways disturbed...
- 7 out of 10 boat owners says that boating has a positive impact on own general health
 - 5 out of 10 not-boat-owners says the same

Aprox . 750 000 pleasure crafts in Norway

- Motorboat without sleepover facilities the largest group
- 1 out of 4 are motorboats with sleepover facilities
- 3 out of 10 are 'small boats'
- Sailboats = 7 %
- Aprox 210 000 boats have sleepover facilities

«The term «pleasure craft» does not include surfboards, sailboards, personal watercraft and dinghies belonging to another boat»





- We asked for some data about the households largest boat
- The «jeep» and the daycruiser are the most common types, aprox ca 21 % of each
- RIB-boats is the smallest group (1,5%)

Some technical data on the Norwegian boats;

- Material
 - 8 out of 10 boats are GRP
 - 1 out of 10 is made by wood
- Year of manufacture
 - 1 out of 3 boats built 2000 and later
 - Which means that 33% are CE-marked
 - 1 out of 2 boats built 1990 or later
- Length
 - 1 out of 3 shorter than 15 feet
 - 1 out of 2 boats between 15-33 feet
 - Less than 10% longer than 34 feet
- Speed
 - 1 out of 2 have top speed above 20 knots
 - Less than 10% have top speed above 40 knots
- The Engine
 - 1 out of 2 have an outboard engine
 - 1 out of 4 have an inboard diesel engine
 - 1 out of 2 of main boats have 50 hp or more
 - 1 out of 2 have an engine built 2000 or later

The use of Norwegian boats represent large values

- The households spent approx. **NOK 6,25 billion** on the use and maintenance of pleasure craft.
- Major cost components are fuel, docking, maintenance, insurance and «in-harbour» costs
 - Consumption pr day of use, kr 418,-
 - Seasonal costs pr household kr 14 228,-
- Increasing interest for «turn-key» solutions from yards and marinas
1 out of 10 will buy more services in the future

86% of the households who own a boat, used it in 2011

- Location
 - 3 out of 4 boats located at the coast
- Dock/mooring
 - More than 4 out of 10 privately docked
 - Almost 2 out of 10 in a commercial marina
 - More than 1 out of 10 in non-commercial marina
- Distance
 - 3 out of 10 boats located closer than 1 km from home
 - 3 out of 10 boats located between 1-10 km from home
- Boat captains
 - In more than 50% of the households who own a boat, there were two, or more captains in the household.
- Charter
 - Less than 1,5% of boat owners have rented out their boat
- Journeys abroad
 - 6 % have made a journey from Norway to other countries
 - 23 % of the sailboats have been abroad in 2011
 - Primary destinations Sweden and Denmark




Daytrips and fishingtrips dominate the picture of use




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

- 1 av 25 var selv i en opplevd farlig situasjon i 2011


- Personlig redningsutstyr

- Kun 2,5% bruker det aldri


- Gransking av ulykker


